Archbishop O'Malley asked that I respond to your letter of June 12, 2005. In that letter you raise issues regarding the bank accounts of the former St. Jeremiah Parish, Framingham and three points about personal property.

It is the Archdiocese's Policy to maintain the segregation of funds of suppressed Parishes until all Civil and Canonical appeals have been exhausted. Therefore, in uniformity with that Policy the bank accounts of the former St. Jeremiah Parish remain frozen.

Without investigating the current status of the personal property of the former St. Jeremiah Parish, I can assure you that should the appeal be successful these items will be returned or replaced.
