As you know, today marks thirty days since the date of your appeal to me that I revoke the decree that suppressed Saint Jeremiah Parish. It has been my practice to consult with advisors before responding to such appeals in order to assure that they are answered properly. In light of a series of commitments in recent weeks I have not had the opportunity as yet to consult with advisors about your appeal. I am grateful for your agreeing to grant a two-week extension to the thirty-day period for me to reply to the appeal, an agreement facilitated by your conversations with Fr. Mark O'Connell. This letter confirms that the new date for you to receive a reply to your appeal is July 5, 2005.
